

Nottingham District Open Day – Car Parking Instructions

West Bridgford, St Giles

It is recommended to use a pay and display car park off Bridgford Road, opposite Park Avenue. It costs £1 for two hours. There is a very small church car park (8 spaces) off Bridgford road, near Church Drive. The entrance has a blue sign saying 'St Giles Parish Church'. Parking is restricted on Church Drive outside the church. Very limited parking on residential roads.

Entrance to the church is through the south door from Church Drive.

Wilford, St Wilfrid (GF)

There is some parking on St Wilfrid's Church Drive, which leads to the church. There is a small church hall car park, access from St Wilfrid's Church Drive. Parking is also available on Main Road. A Sat Nav may try and take you up Rectory Drive by the Ferry Inn. Do NOT drive up this path.

Entrance to the church is through the south door.

Clifton, Holy Trinity

The church is next to the Farnborough Road roundabout near the south end of Southchurch Drive. There is a big free car park opposite the church by the shops. Be careful not to drive in the car park exit.

Entrance to the church is through the west door.

Clifton, St Francis

The church is next to the Farnborough Road roundabout near the north end of Southchurch Drive. There is a small church car park (6 spaces) next to the church hall. There is some on-street parking in Doverby Road and other residential roads nearby.

Entrance to the church is through a door in the tower, the other side to the church hall.

Clifton, St Mary

The church is down Clifton Hall Drive. There is a large car park outside the church.

Entrance to the church is through the south door.

Dunkirk, Red Light Ring

10, Ednaston Road, Dunkirk, Nottingham, NG7 2JF. Parking is allowed on all the residential streets nearby. The 'permit holders only' restriction is Monday to Friday.

Lenton, Holy Trinity

The church is on Church Street, the west side of Lenton Boulevard. There is a small church car park off Church Street. Parking is also available on Church Street.

Entrance to the church is through the north door.

Aspley, St Margaret

The church is on Aspley Lane, just before Lambert Gardens. There are two large church car parks. There is a drive on each side of the church, which lead to the car parks. There is a small road round the back of the church hall, which links the two car parks.

Entrance to the church is likely to be the main south door (otherwise use the door on the car park side, up the steps).

Basford, St Leodegarius

The church is at the junction of Church Street and Bailey Street. There is a very small car park (4 spaces) on Church Street. On-street parking is available on Bailey Street, opposite the church.

Entrance to the ringing chamber is at the base of the tower.

Daybrook, St Paul

The church is on Church Drive just off Mansfield Road (A60). There is on-street parking available on Church Drive and Church Crescent.

Entrance to the church is likely to be the north door (otherwise south door at the foot of the tower).

Arnold, St Mary

The church is on Church Lane. There is a large car park off Church Lane at the rear of the church by the playing field.

Entrance to the church is through the west door.

Bulwell, St Mary and All Souls

The church is off Highbury Road, just by Church Lane. There is a large church car park (20 spaces) in the church yard. Assuming you are approaching the church from the south on Highbury Road, when you see the tower turn right as if to go down Church lane, but turn about 350 degrees up a very steep hill into the car park. Beware of cars coming out of the car park.

Entrance to the church is through the west door.

Nuthall, St Patrick (GF)

The church is on Kimberley Road. There is parking on Kimberley Road and Maple Drive.

Entrance to the church is through the south door.

Wollaton, St Leonard

There is no parking directly outside the church. There is parking on Wollaton Road, just north of the church and on Bramcote Lane and the streets off this road. There is also the Admiral Rodney pub car park, which is pay and display for £1.

The entrance to the tower is on the far side from the entrance to the church grounds. You will need to walk all the way round the church.

Trowell, St Helen

There is parking on Stapleford Road (A6007) and on Church close.

The entrance to the ringing chamber is on south side of the tower.

Stapleford, St Helen

Church Lane is ONE WAY. Do not turn into Church Lane from the B6003 (Church Street). There is parking on Frederick Road, Albert Street and 3 spaces on Church Lane.

The entrance to the church is through the south door.

Bramcote, St Michael & All Angels (GF)

There is a large church car park off Church Street.

The entrance to the church is up the stone steps, the next entrance along from the church hall.

Attenborough, St Mary the virgin

There is very limited parking on Church Lane. Please do not block the road. There is more parking on St Mary's Close.

When you enter the church grounds turn right and walk to the door at the end of the path (ignore the signs to the church entrance).

Beeston, St John the Baptist

There is a pay and display car park on Foster Avenue (at the end of Chilwell Road), which is free for 1 hour. There is some parking in Church Street and at the Manor surgery car park off Chilwell Road (near Church Street).

The entrance to the ringing chamber is from a door at the base of the tower.

Nottingham, All Saints (see map)

The church is on Raleigh Street. There are many one way roads in this area. From Alfreton Road (A610), immediately take the first right onto Cromwell Street. There is a small church car park (6 spaces), through the arch way. All on-street parking is 'permit holders only' until 5pm, so parking outside the church should be fine at this time.

The entrance to the ringing chamber is at the base of the tower.

Nottingham, St Peter (see map)

Park in Fletcher Gate (Lace Market) car park. £2.80 for up to 2 hours. On the Fletcher Gate car park map, the church is at the west end of St Peter's Gate. Alternatively, park at The Forest park & ride and catch the tram into Nottingham, which will cost £3 per person. See www.thetram.net/parkride for further details.

The entrance to the ringing chamber is at the west side of the tower.

Nottingham, St Mary (see map)

Park in Fletcher Gate (Lace Market) car park. £2.80 for up to 2 hours. On the Fletcher Gate car park map, the church is at the south end of St Mary's Gate.

The entrance to the ringing chamber is at the base of the tower.
